Starting November 1st, ELPL will offer a brand new streaming service for patrons, known as **Qello**.

Located under the 'Online Resources' tab on our website, **Qello** allows patrons with an East Longmeadow library card to stream thousands of concerts and music documentaries in high-quality formats, create playlists, and select from over 30 music genres, including rock,

classical, reggae, and country.
